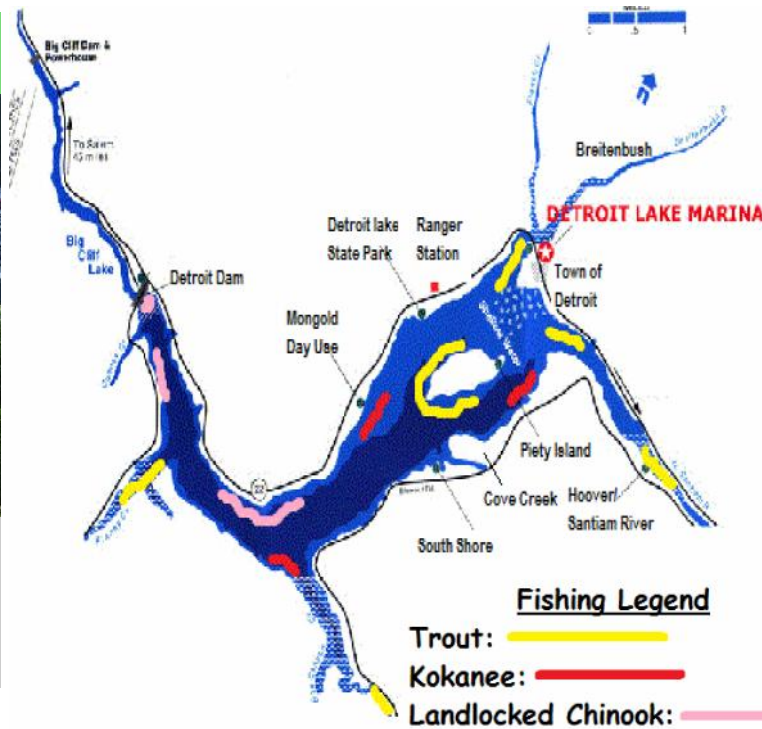


Detroit Lake Marina

Detroit Lake is a reservoir impounded by the Detroit Dam on the North Santiam River 46 miles southeast of Salem, Oregon.

Detroit Lake is stocked by the ODFW with 125,000 catchable Rainbow Trout along with Kokanee and Chinook Salmon.

Techniques for Detroit Lake

Rainbow Trout: Trolling with a spinner such as a Wedding Ring or Rooster Tail and night crawlers. Attaching flashers like Ford Fenders can be used in deeper water. Bank anglers can cast spinners or fish with worms, Power Bait or salmon eggs floated off the bottom or with a bobber.

Kokanee: Common techniques include jigging with Buzz Bombs or kokanee jigs (pink or red are effective) and trolling using a Ford Fender or other flashers with a spinner behind it and some white corn or piece of worm on the hook.

Landlocked Chinook: Down riggers are the most affective. Chinook are 150 -200ft deep. K-5 Quick Fish or Needle-fish work great. (Try pickled herring)

Catfish: Fish the shallows of the Detroit Flats with catfish nuggets.
